2024 TUGBOAT ROUNDUP VENDOR APPLICATION AND CONTRACT

Directions

- 1. **Fill Out the Application and Contract:** Ensure all the information is complete and correct to avoid any delays in the review process.
- 2. **Prepare the Payment:** Write a check for the specified amount that corresponds to the vendor fee. Ensure the check is payable to the Town of Waterford.
- 3. **Certificate of Insurance (For Food Vendors):** If you are selling food, you must include a Certificate of Insurance with your application. This certificate must show a General Liability coverage of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence. Additionally, the Declarations Page must list "The Town of Waterford, the Village of Waterford, the County of Saratoga, the New York State Canal Corporation, and the New York Power Authority, ATIMA" as Additional Insured for the duration of the event.
- 4. **Mail the Documents:** Once you have your completed application and contract, along with the check and, if applicable, the Certificate of Insurance, mail these documents to:

- 5. **Deadline:** Ensure that your application, check, and any other required documents are received by August 1, 2024. If you're applying after this date, you must first email ClearyJ@town.waterford.ny.us to check if there is still available space before sending your application.
- 6. **Prohibited Items:** Be aware that you cannot sell weapons, explosives, obscene materials, illegal substances, tobacco or vaping products, or alcohol (unless given explicit permission as part of the farmers market or other controlled event).

Important Information

- Tugboat Roundup is September 6th (4pm-8pm), 7th (10am-9pm), and 8th (10am to 2pm). Friday is optional for vendors.
- Spaces are \$150 per 10x10 space.
- A \$50 discount is available to organizations who demonstrate a 501(c)(3) status (documentation must be provided with the application)
- Tugboat Roundup takes places along a .5 mile stretch of waterfront space with varying degrees of accessibility by car.
- Specific spots may be requested but are not guaranteed.
- Multi-level marketing companies are prohibited with the exception of those who have participated in the last three years.
- Generators are discouraged. Should they be necessary for a food vendor, the generator noise levels must be below 60 decibels (dB) at a distance of ten feet.
